“Images of nature in Heathmont 3135”

Formerly known as South Ringwood, Heathmont was named in the 1920s when it was orchard area each side of Canterbury Road with Dandenong Creek its southern boundary. From the 1950s Melbourne suburban spread reached the area and it changed from rural to suburban. A village strip shopping centre developed each side of the railway station. Today, Heathmont is an attractive, leafy suburb with a range of parks, cafes, restaurants, sporting facilities and a considerable amount of urban development.

Rules and Guidelines - details

Subject : “Images of nature in Heathmont 3135”

All photos entered must have been taken in 2017 in Heathmont - its reserves, plant-life, landscape or nature including animals and people (you must obtain permission from any identifiable people). You may add a caption to your photo.

Details...

Print Entries and Print Sizes: Any size from postcard to A3+. Unmounted or mounted. No framed entries please.

Fee is \$5 per print, \$2 juniors under 16 - you may enter as many prints as you wish.

New in 2017: Electronic Entries will be for display only, will not be awarded a prize and are judged in the People's-Choice category through Instagram.

- All electronic entries must be posted on Instagram with the hashtag #Heathmont3135. A maximum of ten entries per person may be entered.
- To be judged for People's Choice - Electronic, the entry must also be emailed to hucclphotos@gmail.com
- Electronic entries received at the email address by 1pm Friday 30 September will be displayed by projector at the public display. Electronic entries will not be printed.
- People's Choice - Electronic, a certificate will be awarded to the entry with the most likes on Instagram.
- Electronic entries may also be entered in the Print competition using the requirements of the print competition, ie. with appropriate entry form and fee by the due date.
